Commencing allocations for 2013/14 water year

The NSW Office of Water (NOW) this morning announced commencing allocations for water users in the Murray and Lower Darling valleys for the 2013/14 water year.

Murray Irrigation general security (Class C) customers will commence on 38 percent of water entitlements, while high security customers will commence on 97 percent.

General security licence holders have access to water carried over from 2012/13, up to a maximum of 50 percent of water entitlements. This carryover, plus 2013/14 allocations, cannot exceed 110 percent of water entitlements.

Murray Irrigation customers' carryover (on-farm) is an average of 12 percent of general security water entitlements.

NOW has announced it will make allocation announcements on the 15th of each month until full allocations are reached. As water is used, and new inflows are captured, allocations are expected to increase.
