Water Ordering system

As part of the rebranding of Murray Irrigation's water ordering system, the address for the web ordering site has changed to water.murrayirrigation.com.au. On-farm delivery data

NSW Grain Harvest Scheme

Murray Irrigation has advised local councils of its approval of the NSW Grain Harvest Scheme which is to operate for a trial period of seven months (during the region's grain harvest season). The scheme allows heavy vehicles to operate above the normal general mass limits for such vehicles while the scheme is in operation and if approved by local councils. Customer water ordering

Since the start of the 2013/14 irrigation season, customers have lodged over 9,000 orders with the new water ordering system. Of these orders, approximately 80 percent have been placed via the internet.

Benefits of placing orders via the web include the ability to view the order details on the screen to check for accuracy before lodging the order, less time needed to place an order, and the ability to view all your orders on the screen, whether they are 'pending' or 'operating'.
