Six percent opening allocation for general security entitlements

The Department of Primary Industries (DPI) this morning announced a six percent allocation for general security and 97 percent for high security entitlements holders in the NSW Murray.

Murray Irrigation has announced six percent for general security (Class C) customers and 97 percent for high security (Class A and Class B).

DPI announced general security entitlement holders will have full access to water carried over from 2013/14.

Inter and intra-valley trade in the regulated NSW Murray also resumed today, however trade into and out of the regulated Lower Darling remains suspended because of storage levels in Menindee Lakes.

DPI has advised the next allocation announcement will be made on Tuesday 15 July.
