

Allocation announcement

Murray Irrigation

The NSW Office of Water today announced a three percent increase in the general security announced allocation taking the announced allocation to 52 percent in the NSW Murray.

As a result of this increase Murray Irrigation's announced allocation is now 52 percent for general security (Class C) entitlement customers.

The Office of Water stated the NSW Murray increase came from good rainfall and reduced demand.

The Office of Water has announced that delivery of trade water to the Murray in December and January has enabled the resumption of trade **out** of the Murrumbidgee valley.

Trade to and from the Lower Darling remains closed due to storage levels in the Menindee Lakes.

The NSW Office of Water confirmed the next allocation announcement would be on Monday 2 February 2015.
