

Allocation announcement

Murray Irrigation

The NSW Office of Water today announced no increase in the general security announced allocation in the NSW Murray.

As a result, Murray Irrigation's announced allocation remains at 59 percent for general security (Class C) entitlement customers.

There is no change to annual trade arrangements.

Trade into and out of the Murrumbidgee Valley remains open and the Barmah Choke trade restriction is in operation, meaning there is no net trade downstream of the Barmah Choke.

Trade to and from the Lower Darling remains closed due to storage levels in the Menindee Lakes.

The NSW Office of Water confirmed the next allocation announcement would be on Monday 16 March 2015.
