

Allocation announcement

Murray Irrigation

The NSW Office of Water today announced no increase in the general security announced allocation in the NSW Murray.

As a result, Murray Irrigation's announced allocation remains at 61 percent for general security (Class C) entitlement customers.

There is no change to annual trade arrangements.

Trade into and out of the Murrumbidgee Valley remains open, with some capacity still available for trade downstream across the Barmah choke by virtue of net trades upstream.

Trade to and from the Lower Darling remains closed due to storage levels in the Menindee Lakes.

The NSW Office of Water advised that this would be the last allocation announcement for the 2014/15 season. Any further resource improvement at this late time of the water year will go towards a better opening season allocation on 1 July.

Customers are reminded that the end-of-season close to interstate trade (to or from Victoria or South Australia) is 5.00pm Wednesday 29 April.

An update to the Murray water allocation outlook for 2015/16 will be provided on Friday 15 May 2015.
