Senate Inquiry submissions due

Customers are reminded that submissions to the Senate Inquiry into the positive and negative impacts of the Murray-Darling Basin Plan are due today, Friday 25 September.

The areas specifically being reviewed by the Committee (terms of reference) in summary are:

- The implementation of the Basin Plan;
 - Its progress
 - Its cost
 - Its direct and indirect effects.
- Evidence of environmental change to date;
- The constraints management strategy – effectiveness and appropriateness; and
- Any related matter.

Submissions do not need to address all terms and need not be long. Submissions should include who you are and why the Basin Plan matters to you. It should clearly articulate what impacts the Basin Plan is having on:

- You personally;
- Your business or the business you deal with;
- Your community; and
- The environment.
