Shareholder Directors elected

Chris Brooks, John Bradford and Mark Robertson have been elected to the Murray Irrigation Board of Directors following the declaration of the postal ballot by the Australian Electoral Commission.

Current Director Roger Reynoldson was not re-elected and candidate Gary Hare was not elected.

New Director Chris Brooks is Managing Director of Ray Brooks Limited, a grain trading and freight company based in Barooga and runs his own farming business.

New Director John Bradford runs a farming business near Mayrung. He was recently elected as a Director of Sunrice and the Rice Marketing Board and is currently Chairman of Southern Riverina Irrigators.

Voting in the postal ballot closed at 5.00pm on Friday 9 October. Five candidates nominated for the three shareholder director vacancies that arose from the Company Constitution requirement setting a term of office of four years with re-election via rotation.

Of the 2,578 ballot papers issued, 1,051 admissible ballot papers (41%) were returned. The appointment of the three Directors will be confirmed at the 2015 Annual General Meeting to be held on Thursday 19 November at 7pm at the Deniliquin RSL.

The term of the appointments will be until the 2019 Annual General Meeting.
