Murray Irrigation

Off allocation access to finish Saturday

Based on the current rate of diversions, Murray Irrigation expects to exhaust its available supplementary allocation by tomorrow, Saturday 29 October.

This is due to an increase in customer demand, which has lifted diversions at both the Mulwala and Wakool Canal offtakes.

To date, Murray Irrigation has used 107GL of its supplementary licence, with 14GL remaining.

Customers are reminded that if they do not lodge a finish order for the end of the off allocation water access period, water deliveries beyond this date will be accounted as allocation water.

If customers do not want to continue irrigating with allocation water, a finish order must be placed before 6.30am on Sunday 30 October.
