Shareholder Director elected

Mr Bruce Simpson has been elected to the Murray Irrigation Board of Directors following the declaration of the postal ballot by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) today.

Bruce Simpson is a Director of Peppin Planners in Deniliquin and was previously a Director of F.S. Falkiner & Sons and manager of the irrigation operation for 12 years. Bruce is currently Chair of the Murray Group of Concerned Communities (MGCC) and has more than 36 years experience in water management and the industry. Bruce, along with his wife and two children, owns and operates an irrigation farm located in Denimein.

Bruce has been elected for his first term as a director of Murray Irrigation.

Voting in the postal ballot closed at 5.00pm Friday 3 August. Three candidates nominated for the shareholder director casual vacancy created by the resignation of Stewart Ellis in May.

Of the 2,249 ballot papers issued, 1,203 ballot papers were returned, with three of these declared informal.

Bruce will commence his duties as a shareholder director from the August Board of Directors meeting, with the appointment to be confirmed by the 2012 Annual General Meeting to be held on Thursday 29 November.

The term of the appointment will be until the 2013 Annual General Meeting.
