## Shareholder Directors elected

Bruce Simpson, James Sides and Tim McKindlay have been elected to the Murray Irrigation Board of Directors following the declaration of the postal ballot by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) today.

Noel Graham was not re-elected.

New incoming Director, James Sides, is Real Estate Manager at Landmark Harcourts Deniliquin, Chairman of West Berriquin Landholders' Association and runs his own farming business.

Voting in the postal ballot closed at 5.00pm Friday 11 October. Four candidates nominated for the three shareholder director vacancies that arose from the Company Constitution requirement setting the term of office of four years via rotation.

Of the 2,091 ballot papers issued, 1,137 ballot papers were returned, with two of these declared informal.

The appointment of the three Directors will be confirmed by the 2013 Annual General Meeting to be held on Thursday 21 November.

The term of the appointment will be until the 2017 Annual General Meeting.
